## **COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH – *EARLSWOOD***

The residents of *Reigate and Banstead*, fully supported by the Parish Councils and Surrey County Council Highways, and working in partnership with Surrey Police, are monitoring vehicle speeds at various locations in the Borough in an effort to reduce the number of drivers who choose to exceed the 30 and 40 mph limits.

This is not an enforcement check, but vehicle details will be passed to Surrey Police who will in turn be writing to registered keepers asking them to encourage those who use the vehicle to keep to the speed limits through the Borough. Drivers who regularly offend may be targeted by police enforcement checks.

This scheme is community led and is run by volunteers from the speed watch area.
